PROPOSITION PROS & CONS ON LEAGUE TV SHOW - CH. 2 AND CH. 21

The League of Women Voters of San Luis Obispo County has produced a two-part special edition of "SLO Democracy," presenting a nonpartisan panel discussion of the pros and cons of all nine propositions on the November 2 ballot.

Each half-hour segment of the show covers four or five of the measures. Part one of the program focuses on propositions 19,20,22,23 and 27; part two, 21, 24, 25 and 26.

The discussion panel features **Trudy Jarratt**, first vice president of the League of Women Voters of California; **Sara Horne**, immediate vice president of the local League and recent recipient of the League's first Sara Award, named and given in honor of her voter education work; and **Boyd Horne** and **Janet Kourakis**, local League members. The show is moderated by **Adele Stern**, a past president of the local League and past board director on the state League board.

Up through the election, the show can be viewed on an ongoing basis on countywide government access television Charter Channel 21. The schedule is updated daily at www.SLOSPAN.org.

In addition, throughout the month of September, the program will be broadcast on public access Charter Channel 2. Part one can be seen on Mondays at 9:30 p.m.; part two on Saturdays at 9:30 p.m.

Starting in October, DVDs of the show will also be available through community libraries.

The League's television show and its moderation of forums are strictly nonpartisan. The goal is to provide information about contests and propositions appearing on local ballots that will help voters make informed decisions.
